SPAGS DIVERSITY POSTER AWARD (2 winners) Deadline: October 8, 2018

The SPAGS Diversity Poster Award is given to two students, one winner per poster session, that present the best personality assessment research as it contributes to diversity, multiculturalism, and/or social justice. The poster must have at least one identifiable research question that concerns diversity, multiculturalism, and/or social justice with regard to assessment, and the implications of the results must be interpreted and discussed on the poster. Furthermore, one or more aspects of diversity, multiculturalism, and/or social justice must be integral to key findings of the poster/project. For instance, a study that includes an extremely diverse sample but does not analyze data comparing different groups or comment on the finding(s) of that analysis would not meet inclusion criteria simply because an extremely diverse sample was used.

It is expected that the student presenting the results of the research is the first author and plans to attend the forthcoming SPA Annual Convention. Applicants will indicate their interest in being considered during abstract submission. Applicants interested in having their posters reviewed for the SPAGS Diversity Poster Award will also be required to submit a copy of their poster to the Administrative Director of SPA, who will then distribute the posters to the reviewers. Posters from graduate or undergraduate students who are Student Affiliates of SPA (i.e., SPAGS members), or who apply for Student Affiliate status at the time of abstract submission, will be reviewed by SPA and SPAGS Board Members. During the convention, winners will be honored with a dedicated location to display their poster during their poster session, at which time they will also be awarded with a certificate and monetary award in the amount of \$100. Winners, and their poster abstracts, will also be featured in *The Exchange*.
